As part of this we encourage active travel for all our school community for the following reasons:

- Walking to school keeps us fit and healthy
- It also helps our pupils develop road safety skills which will keep them safe in later life
- We believe road safety is a life skill that everyone should be able to benefit from
- Walking helps keep our local air clean, and our streets free from congestion
- Local residents don't like it when there are too many cars in the road outside their house



What we do:

- We encourage all members of our school community to walk to school
- We provide a map of the local area (see attached)
- We let all new parents / carers know that we are an active travel school before their child starts at our school
- All local school trips are made by public transport where possible, or on foot if the destination is close by
- Where a car must be used we ask all parents to drive only part of the way, park away from the school
 and walk the last part of the journey ('park and stride')
- We promote safe and active travel as much as possible by using our banner, newsletter and website

- Encourage children to walk, walk and stride or use travel by public transport for the journey to school.
