In History this week you looked at Victorian toys and how they compared to the toys of today. A very popular toy in the Victorian era was a thaumatrope. A thaumatrope is an optical toy. A disk with a picture on each side is attached to two pieces of string. When the strings are twirled quickly between the fingers the two pictures appear to blend into one.

For your homework I would like you to make a thaumatrope.

You will need:

- Thaumatrope design (attached to your newsletter)
- Scissors
- 2 pieces of string

When you have made your thaumatrope ask your grown up to film you using it, and post it into your portfolio on Class Dojo.

You **DO NOT** need to bring your thaumatropes back in to school.
