## Upcoming Event

Their design can show whatever is important to them about Class 1, such as the people in the class, the things they like to do in class, important features of the class such as Jesus, Mickey Mouse etc. *They need to have the words Class 1 Family as part of their badge design.* The children need to complete their design on the template on their homework



sheet and then bring this back into school. I am going to try and get their badges then made for them to wear.

There is also another 'Storytime With Jesus' for the children to watch this week.



Well, we have had a very busy first week back in Class 1 after our half term holiday. During the first half of the week we enjoyed sharing our half term adventures that you had posted on to Dojo. It was clear that the children had lots of fun whilst they were off.
