Class One 100 Years of Wonder Celebration

This year the Walt Disney Company celebrates its 100th anniversary. As you know Disney plays a very key feature within Class 1 so we are joining in with the 100th anniversary celebrations. The theme for the anniversary is '100 Years of Wonder' and we will be continuing this theme in our own celebrations. We are very much a community in Class 1, of teachers, children and their families, and we want our celebrations to reflect this. We would like all members of our community (children, parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, brothers, sisters etc.) to contribute to our celebrations by submitting creations of their favourite characters (this could be through drawing, painting, model making, baking...any creative form that you like), photos of trips to a Disney park if you have visited one of those, memories of seeing your first Disney film anything at all Disney related. We would like to create an historical class record spanning as many generations as possible.

How Does The Celebration Work?

Children and families will be able to submit their memories, creations, photos etc. either digitally by emailing me at swright@stpetersprimry.org or via Class Dojo, or physically by sending things in with the children. This will be collated together to create an historical record of the 100 Years of Wonder that is personal to our class family. We are calling all of our submissions **Wonder Memories** to recognise the 100 Years of Wonder. During the Pentecost Term we shall hold an 'exhibition' of things that have been submitted for the celebration to which you will be invited. There will also be a very special treat during the Pentecost Term for the children, details of which will be shared nearer the time.



What Wonder Memories Can Be Submitted?

Wonder is limitless and memories are personal so we are putting no limit on what the form your Wonder Memories are in. We would love to see a whole range of ways that the Wonder Memories are presented such as through, art, photos, written memories, video memories, sculpture...the choice is yours. The only stipulation is that your Wonder Memory show how Disney has played a role in your life be it through films, books, stories, shows, characters...any way at all. These can also be memories related to Pixar, Star Wars and Marvel characters, not just limited to the classic Disney characters.

When Do Wonder Memories Need To Be Submitted By?

Please submit all entries for the festival by Friday 21st April 2023 The half term and Easter holidays are great opportunities to get those Wonder Memories together and to also get Wonder Memories from other members of the family. During the time leading up to 21st April we shall send occasional reminders and some of the home challenges will be linked to Wonder Memories.

How Many Wonder Memories Can Be Submitted?

Your child and family may submit as many pieces of celebration memories as you wish. It would be amazing if every child and their family could submit at least wonder memory for our celebration.
