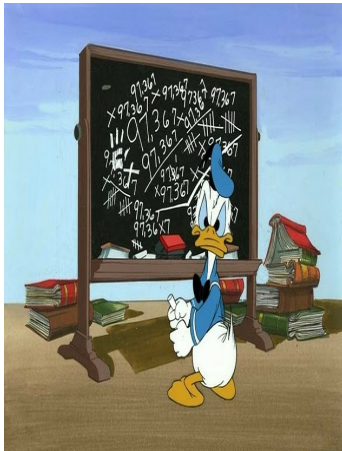
RSHE

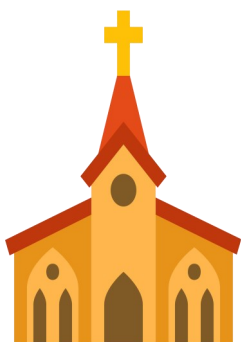
