

This week in RE we have been thinking about the Presentation of the Gifts during Mass. We spent some time acting out the gifts being presented to the priest, and then the priest blessing them. We discovered that when the priest blesses the host (bread) and wine they become the body and blood of Christ, just like they did for the disciples at Jesus' Last Supper. The priest and the Extra-Ordinary Minister

then use the gifts to give Holy Communion to the parish family, or the priest gives a blessing. The children all did some lovely work in the RE books all about this part of the Mass, talking about what the gifts were and some of the things that are said.

Next week we shall be starting our new RE topic all about 'Change.' During this topic we shall look closely at the events of Holy Week in the lead up to the Easter story.
