Maths

This week in Maths we finished exploring numbers and we started to do some work on shape. The first shape that we looked at was a circle. We hunted for circles around our classroom, and examined how a circle has no straight lines. See if you can find any circles at home.

I have been absolutely blown away by the amount of progress that **all** of the children have made in such a short amount of time at school. I am immensely proud of each and every one of them. Thank you so much for your support at home too with the phonics. This has had such a positive impact on how well the children have done.
